<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Homogenisation for known uses• Systematisation of basic data structures with an option to extend them• Description of vocabularies<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Thesauri, terminologies, word lists, descriptions of terms• Documentation of knowledge organisation and knowledge representation• Description of silent knowledge of "how things are done"• Description of anomalies	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Homogenisation with a clear aim• Systematisation of how knowledge should or must be represented• Systematisation of what knowledge can be created• Cleaning for the sake of cleaning• Forced templates• Overdocumentation• Belief in that all can/must be documented
